INFORMATION WE COLLECT

COOKIES / ADVERTISING

For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on your browser or the hard drive of your computer. Cookies are very small files in plain text that are sent to and stored on your computer, tablet or smart phone whenever you visit a website.
